#### CLOTHING

#### DO NOT INCLUDE

-Used or damaged items
-War related items such as toy guns,
knives, or military figures
-Chocolate or food
-Out of date candy
-Liquids/Lotions
-Medications/Vitamins
-Breakable items like glass
-Aerosol cans
